ORDINANCE CHAPTER 26

THE USE OF SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTIONS HELD WITHIN THE TOWN OF DODGEVILLE

The Town Board of the Town of Dodgeville, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Whereas, Wisconsin State Statutes allow for the use of split shifts at elections; and

Whereas, the Town of Dodgeville does hereby deem it necessary and beneficial to implement the use of split shifts as needed at elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DODGEVILLE, IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: POLLING PLACE SHIFTS

(1) Two sets of officials may work at different times on election day and the Town Clerk or his/her designee may in his or her discretion establish different working hours for different officials assigned at the same polling place."

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect on August 1st, 2012.
