## Town of Dodgeville Code of Ordinances Chapter 7 Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage Licenses November 7th, 2018

The Board of the Town of Dodgeville, Iowa County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Pursuant to Town Board action on November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Chapter 7 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances is hereby Amended as follows:

The addition of Section 7-5 Maintaining of License which should read as follows:

- A. It shall be a condition of holding a license in the Town of Dodgeville; that the licensee continues in business. Issuance of, or retention of, a license by a party not doing business or intending to resume doing business without a board approved timeline, is hereby declared to be against public policy, and lacking in usefulness.
- B. Any license issued pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to such further regulations and restrictions as may be imposed by the Town Board by amendments or by the enactment of new ordinances.
- C. Holders of such licenses are required to possess the following: A premise (Facility) from which to conduct business, sanitary permit, building permits, Conditional Use Permits (CUPs) when required in accordance with the applicable Zoning Code and/or Iowa County Zoning Ordinance. Further, holders of such licenses must possess necessary federal I.D. numbers, State of Wisconsin sales tax numbers, and shall meet and continue to meet on an ongoing basis all other state and federal requirements.
- D. "Business continuation" is hereby defined to be as follows: Each license shall be open at least 120 days within each licensing period. The licensing period is defined as the year for which the applicable license is issued to a licensee.
- E. Seasonal businesses must be open in 6 months of the licensing period or be required to obtain an exemption from the Town Board.
- F. Special event businesses must have 8 events a year to maintain a license in the Town of Dodgeville or be required to obtain an exemption from the Town Board.
- G. Business interruption due to bank foreclosure, catastrophe or disaster. In the event that a licensee can not comply with the business continuation requirement as set forth in Section B of the ordinance due to a foreclosure, disaster or catastrophe, including but not limited to fire damage, storm damage, etc., which disaster or catastrophe destroys in part or in whole the premises for which a license is issued, the town board may waive the business continuation requirement for not more than 90 days without a board approved plan.
- 2. This amendment shall take effect beginning with the 2019-2020 licensing year.
